1983 State Budget

Legislators have filed a brief defending constitutionality of 1983 Budget Act. The pro-abortion Committee to defend Reproductive Rights brought suit to prevent implimentation of budget restrictions on abortion funding. The State Supreme Court upheld their petition, thereby, mandating the continued funding of abortion. The legislators brief has been filed to "protect the doctrine of the separation of powers, particularly, the Constitutional division of authority between the legislative and judiciary branches of government:" The concern of the legislators is that the Supreme Court will take control of the power of the purse and thus negate the separation of powers doctrine that must be strongly defended.

The legislators main concern is not abortion funding so much as it is the separation of powers. However, we ought to write to our state legislators supporting this action. It will be very helpful to us if the legislators win!

LATE REPORT. 1/15/84. The \$13.5 million designated by the legislature to fund Medi-Cal abortions has run out half way through the year. Ken Corey, State Comptroller has returned all claims to the Health Dept. unpaid. This will be challenged in the Courts. Please contact your legislators and urge them to maintain their resolve to fight this judicial grab for power of the purse.

Legislative Reform Act

Gann Initiative. One of the pro-life benefits of successful passage of this initiative would be to diffuse the power of the Speaker of the Assembly. It will also establish a fairer proportion of representation by Republicans as well as Democrats on committees. This will be of great benefit to RTL legislation. WATCH FOR IT! STUDY IT CAREFULLY! Who Speaks For The Majority?

Right to life, that's who! We have been conducting a survey devised by the National Right to Life Committee in California to determine the voter's preference regarding abortion. Anyone surveyed who showed even the slightest preference for abortion was placed in the pro-abortion category.

Our survey showed that the pro-choice/pro-life split was 50/50. The question of funding with the tax dollars for abortion showed an interesting split of 75% against government funding with about 25% for government funding. This message should be delivered loud and clear to our legislators.

FEDERAL LEGISLATION

Equal Rights Amendment

Support Sensenbrenner Amendment. Write to both Congressmen and Senators. This fight is not over! Congressman Tip O'Neill has vowed to resuscitate the ERA as many times as he can. The ERA is still in Sen. Orrin Hatch's Senate Judiciary subcommittee awaiting action.

Remind pro-life legislators of their promise to defeat abortion funding. If ERA should ever pass without an abortion neutralizing amendment it will place abortion-on-demand into the constitution. Sen. 'Pete' Wilson, especially, must be contacted. Remind him that this legislation at the federal level will require gender to be viewed as a suspect class just as race is now automatically requiring strict judicial scrutiny. Fetal Experimentation

Support Dannemeyer Amendment. Amending S773 Sen. Hatch's National Institute of Health reauthorization bill. The N.I.H. bill will fund the programs and Grants and awards given by NIH to its various contractors. The Dannemeyer Amendment would prohibit any of this money to be used for experimenting on soon-to-be-aborted, or live-aborted babies. Experimentation is to be done only if some benefit is definitely to be derived by the baby who is suffering from some illness and only after it has been tested in some other manner first.

The Catholic Church and Political Contributions

The following information appeared in an issue of the CALIFORNIA PRO LIFE MEDICAL ASSOCIA-TION dated October 18, 1983.

CALIFORNIANS FOR CHILDREN'S TEXTBOOK RIGHTS was set up by the Catholic Church and its lobbyists in Sacramento. The treasurer was Dr. Joseph McElligot, a lobbyist for the California Catholic Conference, the lobbying arm of the California Catholic Bishops.

The campaign committee conducted a fundraising drive among its members in support of Proposition 9, the textbook initiative. The California bishops contributed more than \$307,000.00 to this cause.

The California Pro Life Medical Association report claims that substantial sums of this money were turned over to pro-abortion Democratic Party polititians in a blatant betrayal of the Catholic contributor's trust. The report cites four examples:

- 1. ART TORRES (D)
- 2. CITIZENS FOR PROGRESS, set up to raise funds to elect Tom Bradley (D), abortion advocate running for Governor \$250.00
- 3. UNITED DEMOCRATIC CAMPAIGN COMMITTEE, set up to elect Democratic party members to judgeships in Los Angeles \$4,000.00
- 4. CALIFORNIA DEMOCRATIC PARTY, official position in favor of the wanton killing of unborn human beings . . . \$15,000.00

No pro-life candidate nor Republican Party candidate received any contributions.



Congressional intent is that any organization that includes abortion as a method of Family Planning is ineligible for Title X Funding.
 Not subject to Hyde Amendment restrictions on abortion.
 Planned Parenthood which receives Title X Funds, indirectly supports abortion, e.g.:

 a. Placed newspaper ads requesting individuals to oppose abortion restrictions.
 b. Executive Director of Indianapolis Planned Parenthood Associates stated that

- - counselors will be prepared to assist minors who do not want parents informed about abortion.
- c. In 1982, a Minnesota Family Planning Center operating under a contract with Planned Parenthood referred clients to an abortion clinic.
 4. Planned Parenthood receives one-third of its funding from Medi-Cal reimbursement, e.g., abortions listed as "menstrual evacuations" are considered "Family Planning expenditures."
